- All vendors must pay an event fee: \$50 for 12'x12' space or \$75 for 12'x24' space by check payable to: "Noelle Adamoschek" with the application postmarked no later than May 19th, 2026. ANY APPLICATIONS RECEIVED AFTER WILL BE CHARGED A NON-REFUNDABLE \$25.
- The CVOG Selection Committee reserves the right to accept or decline any and all applications. The application fee will be returned to vendors not selected. No multi-level marketing vendors.

- **Vendors must provide their own shelter and equipment. Generator use may be acceptable, however must be approved. It is recommended vendors secure their materials overnight as security is limited to lights and cameras. Vendors will be organized into one area adjacent to the competitions.**
- **Vendor assumes all responsibility and liability for all items sold and compliance with applicable laws including NY Department of Health’s Bureau of Community Environmental Health and Food Protection. The acquisition, display and associated fees for temporary food service permits are the responsibility of the vendor.**
- **If the CVOG is cancelled due to unforeseeable circumstances, all vendors will be notified by Tuesday, June 15, 2026, by phone or email and event fees returned.**
